

Middle/High School Supply List

- 3 sharpened pencils
- Pencil sharpener that catches shavings
- 12 count colored pencils
- 2 inch 3-ring binder
- 2 packages lined notebook paper (1 in the binder/1 for classroom use)
- Dividers to separate subjects, label
- Pencil pouch
- Package of wet wipes and sanitizer
