**September 11 - 15**

**1. For God's Favor, Protection, & Peace (Numbers 6:24-26)**

***"The Lord bless you and keep you; the Lord make his face shine on you and be gracious to you; the Lord turn his face toward you and give you peace."***

**2. To Grow In The Fruit Of The Spirit (Galatians 5:22-23)**

***But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, forbearance, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control. Against such things there is no law.***

**3. To Root Their Identity In Christ (1 Peter 2:9)**

***But you are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, God's special possession, that you may declare the praises of him who called you out of darkness into his wonderful light.***

**4. To Experience God's Love For Them (1 John 3:1)**

***See what great love the Father has lavished on us, that we should be called children of God! And that is what we are! The reason the world does not know us is that it did not know him.***

### **5. To Live Courageously (Joshua 1:9)**

***Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged, for the Lord your God will be with you wherever you go.***

### **6. To Feel Content/Satisfied With What They Have (Hebrews 13:5)**

***Keep your lives free from the love of money and be content with what you have, because God has said, "Never will I leave you; never will I forsake you."***

### **7. To Overflow With Gratitude (Colossians 2:6-7)**

***So then, just as you received Christ Jesus as Lord, continue to live your lives in him, rooted and built up in him, strengthened in the faith as you were taught, and overflowing with thankfulness.***

### **8. To Experience Peace That Passes Understanding (Philippians 4:7)**

***And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.***

### **9. To Shine Their Light (Matthew 5:16)**

***In the same way, let your light shine before others, that they may see your good deeds and glorify your Father in heaven.***

### **10. To Feel Unspeakable Joy (1 Peter 1:8-9)**

**Though you have not seen him, you love him; and even though you do not see him now, you believe in him and are filled with an inexpressible and glorious joy, for you are receiving the end result of your faith, the salvation of your souls.**

### **11. To Love God With All They Have (Matthew 22:37)**

**Jesus replied: "Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind."**

### **12. To Be Self-Control And Alert (1 Peter 5:8)**

**Be alert and of a sober mind. Your enemy the devil prowls around like a roaring lion looking for someone to devour.**

### **13. Not To Conform To The Pattern Of This World (Romans 12:2)**

**Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is—his good, pleasing and perfect will.**

**14. For Meaningful Relationships (Ecclesiastes 4:9-11)**

*Two are better than one, because they have a good return for their labor: If either of them falls down, one can help the other up. But pity anyone who falls and has no one to help them up. Also, if two lie down together, they will keep warm. But how can one keep warm alone?*

February 5 - 9

**18. For Sweet Sleep (Proverbs 3:24)**

### **19. For An Active Prayer Life (Matthew 7:7-8)**

***“Ask and it will be given to you; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you. 8 For everyone who asks receives; the one who seeks finds; and to the one who knocks, the door will be opened.***

### **20. To Do Good Works (Ephesians 2:10)**

***For we are God’s handiwork, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do.***

### **21. To Be Forgiving (Ephesians 4:32)**

***Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you.***

## **March 4 - 8**

### **22. To Arm Themselves With The Armor Of God (Ephesians 6:13-17)**

***Therefore put on the full armor of God, so that when the day of evil comes, you may be able to stand your ground, and after you have done everything, to stand. Stand firm then, with the belt of truth buckled around your waist, with the breastplate of righteousness in place, and with your feet fitted with the readiness that comes from the gospel of peace. In addition to all this, take up the shield of faith, with which you can extinguish all the flaming arrows of the***

*evil one. Take the helmet of salvation and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God.*
